SUBJECT PRONOUNS

Los Subject Pronouns o Pronombres de Sujeto son los pronombres que acompañan a un verbo y hacen de sujeto.

E.g.: *I* wake up at 8 o'clock every day

E.g.: *She* goes to work by car

OBJECT PRONOUNS

Los Object Pronouns o Pronombres de Objeto se utilizan detrás de un verbo o detrás de una preposición. Cuando van detrás de un verbo pueden ser Direct Object or Indirect Object al igual que los pronombres de complemento directo e indirecto de castellano:

Direct Object: Have you met Mary? No, I have never met *HER*

Indirect Objects: Give *HIM* the book, please.
